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## **CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS**



The Ontario Secondary School Certificate is a pathway for some students and can also be granted on request to students who leave school before earning the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The requirements for an OSSC are:

**Compulsory Credits (total of 7)** 

- 2 credits in English
- 1 credit in Mathematics
- 1 credit in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian History OR Canadian Geography
- 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- 1 credit in the Arts OR Technological Education

#### Ontario Secondary School Certificate (O.S.S.C.) Requirements

#### Ontario Secondary School Certificate of Accomplishment

Granted to students who are not taking the OSSD or OSSC pathway. The Certificate of Accomplishment may be a useful means of recognizing achievement for students who plan to take certain kinds of further training, or who plan to find employment directly after leaving school.

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

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
# **HWDSB elearning options**



This SHSM is great for students who have a passion for working in the food industry.

#### Students should sign up for at least 2 Hospitality classes in grade 11...these include:

- Hospitality and Tourism (TFJ)
- Baking and Pastry Arts (TFB)
- Event Planning (TFE)
- Cooking/Culinary Arts (TFC)
- Catering (TFJ)

When you participate in the Hospitality SHSM, you will have opportunities to gain real life experiences through reach ahead activities. This could include in-house catering, off site catering, event planning etc.

You will also earn industry recognized certifications that you can showcase on your resume for future employment. One of the requirements to graduate with a Hospitality SHSM designation is students' participation in a Co-op placement in either grade 11 or 12

#### Examples of the Co-op placement could be at any of the following:

- restaurant
- grocery store
- hotel
- hospital kitchen
- kitchen in a retirement or nursing home
- banquet hall
