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CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

The Ontario Secondary School Certificate is a pathway for some students and can also be granted on request to students who leave school before earning the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. The requirements for an OSSC are:

Compulsory Credits (total of 7)

- 2 credits in English
- 1 credit in Mathematics
- 1 credit in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian History OR Canadian Geography
- 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- 1 credit in the Arts OR Technological Education

HWDSB CERTIFICATE OF ACCOMPLISHMENT

- Students who leave school before fulfilling the requirements for the Ontario **Secondary School Diploma** or the Ontario Secondary School Certificate may be granted a Certificate of Accomplishment. The Certificate of Accomplishment may be a useful means of recognizing achievement for students who plan to take certain vocational programs or other kinds of further training, or who plan to find employment after leaving school.

In order to graduate high school with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students will need:

Ontario Secondary School Certificate (O.S.S.C.) Requirements

In order to graduate high school with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students will need:

- ✓ 14 credits (7 compulsory, 7 elective)

Ontario Secondary School Certificate of Accomplishment

Granted to students who are not taking the OSSD or OSSC pathway. The Certificate of Accomplishment may be a useful means of recognizing achievement for students who plan to take certain kinds of further training, or who plan to find employment directly after leaving school.
