Full time training programs include:

 Basic Level 1 Apprenticeship Training Standard (first level of trade school in an expanded format)

Program highlights include:

- Support with securing an 8-week paid work placement

Workplace Safety Training relevant to trade could include:

- Working at Heights / Power Elevated Work
- Platform Training
- First Aid Training / CPR Basic Level 1 Rescuer
- ODP/CFC Training (OPD card)
