- 3) Treasurer's Report:
 - nothing to report as there has been no fundraising, nothing going on
 - Ms. Buck: \$500 Parent Engagement funds given out each year; Mary Hopkins amount spent on online reading subscriptions in both French and English. (This amount is spent on something right away, such as a guest speaker, and so does not hit financial statement as it is not a school-generated fund)
- 4) Principal's Report:
 - Remote learning: staff did a great job of planning ahead, ensuring logins, etc.
 - Managing learning at home:
 - Huge demand, everyone is stressed; hopefully Feb 10th IS our return date

 *Board announced Feb. 3rd that in-person classes will resume Monday, Feb .8th
 - End-of-week Spirit Days until return to school:
 - January 28th, Read My Shirt Day
 - February 5th, Mismatch Day
 - January 29th PA Day: staff consolidating assessments, working on report cards which
 will be sent home February 19th electronically via parent portal. There will be no
 interviews linked to these reports, but teachers MAY reach out or parents and
 caregivers can always be in touch with the school at any time
 - French Immersion (FI):
 - currently, Grade 4 FI students at MH the oldest cohorts
 - Students will move on to Flamborough Centre
 - Mary Hopkins will then be a true 50/50 Dual Track school
 - <u>Kindergarten registration</u> opens February 1st:

- Closed to out of catchment
- Will have a better idea of enrolment once the Board sends projections out mid-Feb: perhaps around 510-515
- Since last year, only online
- Tables may be set up outside the school over multiple days with scheduled time for parents and/or caregivers to come and show paperwork (just need to authenticate, not copy)
- Priority is for kids to have opportunity to see class and meet teacher prior to
 September
- Learn. Disrupt. Rebuild @HWDSB, Ms. Buck sits on this team at the Board:
 - Part of K-12 curriculum
 - Receiving module by module to roll out to students
 - Everyone messaged out together
 - Ms. Buck will will present in more detail at next School Council meeting

- Bigger learning curve than anyone expected
- Attendance IMPRESSIVE; not a fun way to learn, but kids have been FANTASTIC:)
- Everyone is making the best of it, especially with TECH ISSUES :(
- Staff are making accommodations for how things can be "handed in;" finding creative ways to get kids moving
- Staff request, especially with younger online learners: parents and caregivers, please
 help get learning environment set up so teachers can see kiddos. A lot of work going on
 in the early grades is visual, sharing work
- Hard to tell how kids are doing with cameras off please reach out to teacher if your tech does not allow for video or if there are other barriers
