Retell Road

Go on a walk together. Retell what you did and/or saw on the walk using the words first, next, then and last. Challenge- Ask your child to retell their day at school or what happened in a show they watched.

Questions, Questions, Questions

When you are out in your community, share some of your wonderings (e.g., Why is grass green? How are clouds made?). Consider researching the answers together. Challenge- Ask a question about a topic using who, what, when, where, why or how.

Collaborative Story

Choose 4 items you see in your community. Use the 4 items as inspiration to create a story. You can tell the story as you walk and/or you can write it down. Challenge-Make your own book where you take turns drawing and writing the story.

What Do You Think?

As you walk together in your community, take turn sharing your personal opinions related to things you see. Be sure to explain the reason for your opinion (e.g., I like snow because... I do not like pine trees because... I think there should be more parks because...).

Be a Detective

When you are out the community, focus in on a scene and make some inferences (i.e., thinking guesses) about the situation (e.g., What might you infer about two kids walking with backpacks on in the morning?).
