- Before & After School care at Memorial is provided through the YWCA childcare.








# Getting to know your child is our priority

### **DROP OFF/PICK UP**

- Memorial School Bell Times 8:45am-3:05pm
- Educators are on duty in the Kindergarten playground (off of Ottawa St.) starting 15 minutes before the morning bell.
- Most of our students are dropped off to school by their guardians, but we do have a school bus for eligible students. The YWCA child care will also drop off and pick up children who are enrolled in their program.
- Students will only be released to someone on their approved list. If someone different will be picking up your child we must be notified in advance.





### **Nutrition Breaks**

- We have 2 Nutrition Breaks 10:25-11:05 and 12:45-1:25
- We are a Nut safe school
- Lunch containers
- Some guardians choose to label their child's lunch containers with a 1 or 2 to help their children determine which items to eat at each break, or so that your child does not eat everything during 1st break and have nothing left for 2nd break.
