- Round Table

 commencement plan. This will be based on what the Grade 8's want for
 their commencement

 - Part of the Health Curriculum, starts in grade two or three and builds in different grades later on

 - Personal decision, and the risks that are involved in that
 - We understand it is extra and a lot of planning to the trips

- Review of Mission (Every student experiences a sense of belonging and engages in dynamic learning to reach their potential and build their own future) and Board Values (Compassion, Dignity, Trust & Joy)
- MJ School Improvement Plan Focus models the Board Improvement Plan. We are focusing on improving literacy, numeracy (assessment and problem solving, wanting to be able to solve the problem where it is challenging, gaining the enthusiasm to solve) and well being (utilizing data from a survey, and dig into the results so everyone feels heard and that they matter) outcomes for every student. • Principal Updates (Mark Hopkins) Continued

- We will continue to use assessment in literacy and numeracy to guide our instruction using Tier 1 and 2 approaches
- We will be using a co-leadership model to engage in the learning (plan, acting, reflecting, next steps) Literacy: Mme Strong, M. Letchford and Mme Bouquin, Numeracy: Mme Shezad, Well Being: Mme Mizzi and Indigenous Lead (Runner Model): Mme Melanson
- Bus Updates with respect to GPS—Called HWSTS, Sharp is in the process of getting GPS for easier tracking. Our transportation officer has been amazing in problem solving challenges of timing with respect to two of our routes, looked at yellow bus and blue bus routes for some concerns
- Rural Bussing for MJ was raised
 - Perception has been that FI is equivalent to specialty programs (similar to extra circulars) not officially an educational school; this was at a previous board meeting
 - Action Item: Review the reqirements for bussing in particular rural areas (Mark Hopkins)
- Safe Schools Drills (Shelter in Place, Hold and Secure, Bomb Threat/Evacuation Drill) are complete. We will be doing a lockdown in November and the other in February.
- School Generated funds, support SIP, Tech, School Enhancement (Arts, P.E., DPA, Communication), Subsidize excursions
- Action Item: Take a look at Mad Science opportunities (Mark Hopkins)
