HWDSB students and staff are automatically entered to win one of four \$25 Chapters/Indigo Gift Cards when they borrow and read eBooks/eAudio books from eMAX, the HWDSB catalog of Overdrive material, over the summer! Contest Details:

1. The contest is open to HWDSB students and staff only.

2. Contest runs from June 28 to August 31, 2019.

3. Each participant must login with their 9 digit OEN number or 7 digit employee ID to check out eBooks/eAudio books from hwdsb.lib.overdrive.com or use the SORA reading app. OENs are on report cards or available from your school's teacher librarian.

4. Parents/legal guardians of participating students are responsible for ensuring the reading/listening material selected by your student for the contest is appropriate.

5. Names of the students and staff who borrow eBooks/eAudio books during the contest will be entered into a random draw.

6. One winner from each of the four categories: Primary, Junior/Intermediate, Senior and HWDSB Staff, will be randomly drawn and will receive a \$25 Chapters/Indigo gift card. Winners will be notified at their school or work location by September 30, 2019.

With Sora, students can get free ebooks and eAudio books

provided by the HWDSB! SORA APP "How To":

1. Install the Sora app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store, or go to soraapp.com.

 In Sora, find your school, then sign in.
 Each participant must login with their 9 digit OEN number or 7 digit employee ID to check out eBooks and/or eAudio books. (OENs are on report cards or available from your school's teacher librarian.)
 Browse the Explore tab and borrow a book. Your book will open so you can start reading right away.

4. Close the book and go to your Shelf to see all your books. From there, you can:
Tap Open Book or Open Audiobook to read or listen to the book;
