Current student population is 140 in-school & 28 remote school

Remote Learning Program survey that opens January 18-22 can lead to school reorg (similar to what we saw in September) if enough students opt-in to remote learning.

iPads have been distributed to families – about 40 devices were distributed K learning – packages have been made available for any family who would like one either online or through the school
