Mrs. DiToro – Kindergarten: We are set up and sharing our learning on the HUB. We continue to work on expectations and getting to know each others likes and needs.

Mrs. Bailey – Kindergarten: Lots of community building. Getting used to the routines. Check out the HUB for lots of activities and learning.

Mrs. Frizell Grade 1: In language, continuing to work on letters and sounds. Continuing to work on numbers to 50 in math and skip counting. In Science starting a unit on living things. Started DRA.

Mrs. May – Grade ¹/₂: In language working on making connections and thinking about our reading. In math, numbers to 50 and a patterning test on Friday. iPads arrived, and we are learning how to use them, the HUB and Portfolio. Please send in earphones for the children.

Mrs. Price – Grade 2/3: In Math working on numeration and representing numbers and ordinal problems. Still working on DRA. In science, Grade 2s are working on animal habitats and grade 3s are working on plants and their mini gardens.

Mrs. Dahmer – Grade 3: In Math working on representing numbers to 1000s. Review was sent home and test is on Friday. Completing DRA this week. In literacy, narrative writing, read alouds and focusing on Growth Mindset. Announcements updated every Monday on the HUB.

Mrs. Leach – Grade 4: We had many rich discussions surrounding Orange Shirt Day. We connected our class Land Acknowledgement to the story "We Are Water Protectors" pledging to protect the Earth. In Math working on daily number talks, patterning and place value. DRA has started in language. In Science, working on Habitat projects. Check the HUB for photos and updates.

Mrs. Nedelko – Grade 5: In Math working on decimals to the 100s, representing these in fractional form (using a metre stick as a real life example – standing long jump). Terry Fox Graffiti art last week, "Be Like Terry" character traits. On Orange Shirt Day, connected our Orange Shirt designs to stories "Stolen Words" and "I Am Not A Number". Math and word study lists are on the HUB. Online "discussion" on the HUB as well. Students put pictures of their work and art in their Portfolios.

French – Ms. MacCuish: Getting settled into routines and have officially started Prof du Jour which was a favourite last year.

Physical Education – Mrs. Mason: Continue to do the Reimaging Wellness Lesson with Grades 1-3 (a great way to get to know the students on a personal level in PE). Focused on learning some Indigenous Games last week. Terry Fox run went well and raised \$2250. Cross Country on Thursday and students have done so well practising. Starting to work on Halloween Dances.

Empower: Well on it's way and additional small groups mainly focused on reading with start later this month. Grades 3-5 have started using Robots again in Learning Commons and are attempting to use coding concepts.

Budget:

- 2 debits were made this month from the account.

- \$792.70 was debited (\$456 was for agendas, \$326.70 carried over into principal's fund (unspent from last year)).

- \$1317.10 was debited for fibar for playgrounds. Tax was \$167.60 of which \$139.75 was rebated.
