Mrs. DiToro – Kindergarten: Learning about shapes! Kids are excited about the holidays as we are seeing it in their play!

Mrs. Bailey – Kindergarten: Started Art Club with Grade 4 class. Will do the other classes in the New Year. In class focusing on Holiday Celebrations around the world.

Mrs. Frizell Grade 1: In Social Studies working on relationships, roles and responsibilities. In Math working on data. In language working on using the word wall and blends.

Mrs. May – Grade ½: Working on Celebrations around the world. In math working on coding and data management. In language, working on connections, global communities and local communities.

Mrs. Price – Grade 2/3: In language, working on procedural writing. In math working on addition strategies, word problems and rounding numbers. In social studies working on world celebrations (Grade 2) and early communities in Canada (Grade 3)

Budget:

- Halloween Dance-A-Thon total was \$4243.75

- Request for \$800 for guided-reading texts
- \$350 requested for new trike
- \$300 requested for new large parachute
- Many smaller items requested.
- Nicki and Sarah will look into pricing for the wood surrounding the large sandbox.
- Motion to spend \$75 per classroom (\$875 total) to give to teachers to spend on smaller items they need/want, as well as \$250 for parachute and \$350 for trikes. Motion made by Donna Gerritsen. Seconded by Jennifer Woodfine. Approved.
- Motion made by Jennifer Woodfine to spend \$800 on Guided Reading/Decodable Texts (41 books for grades 1-3). 2nd by Nicki Sirtokin. Approved.
