Current student population is 166 in-person and 25 remote

Library clean up has been completed and students can visit the library with their class. Mrs. Hamilton is the educator for the primary grades health and library time.

Thank you to Donna G for running the virtual Scholastic book fair. We have \$200 to purchase additional books for the library.

We are back to doing the holiday Food Drive this year. We have set a goal of 400 items and are halfway there! The food will be donated to the Flamborough Food bank.

Polar Express / pyjama day is on December 17. Students will receive a bag with their ticket and bell for this holiday event.

PA Day – on November 26, Millgrove staff participated in a full day of learning. The morning focus was Mental Health and Well-being / Safe and Inclusive classrooms and the afternoon focus was School Improvement Planning.

Read-a-thon – January reading event – could have a virtual parent component – feedback from SC around format?

Lego wall – Hamilton Foundation for Student Success grant (pitch as a collaborative tool for problem solving and creative solutions)
