

Millgrove Principal's Report – April 2022

- Current student population is 161 in-person and 31 in Grade 5 remote
- Staffing and classroom organization has begun. We are status quo for September 2022.
- Spirit Wear was distributed before March Break – thanks to Mrs. Mason and Mrs. MacDonald for their work to make this happen!
- Photo retake day took place on Monday, April 4
- Air Band 2022 is under way. There are 10 acts and details will be shared with families about the event closer to the date (anticipate it to be the end of May or beginning of June)
- Grade 5 visit to Greenville is scheduled for June 14
- Grade 5 farewell is Tuesday, June 28 – details to follow
- K registration is open so please register your kindergarten age children and ask your neighbours to register their school-age children as well!! 21 new kinders registered as of today. Kindergarten orientation will be May 31 at 5:30 p.m.
- Lunch monitors will resume this week
- Reading buddies and tech buddies will also start up in the next few weeks.
- We have completed our emergency drills for the year – 2 lockdown, 1 hold and secure and 1 shelter in place
- EQAO will take place for Grade 3 students in June
- Have students bring water bottles
- Grade 4 and 5 students are doing virtual tours of the Hamilton dump and learning about conservation of resources as prep for the science curriculum and Earth Day
- Bus situation is resolved as Theresa has returned to Millgrove School!
- Rural school funds - \$4600 (blackboards for kindergarten and outdoor classroom)
Line painting will be \$1000 – will do proceed with the refresh in mid-April
- We are optimistic that we can do a Go for Green spring clean-up even if in a modified format similar to the fall Friday, May 27 or Monday, May 30
