Time: 1:45pm to 2:45pm


Millgrove will continue with its annual Terry Fox Run this year. Terry ran in all types of weather and the Terry Fox School Run will occur rain or shine on that day.

Cancer has, unfortunately, touched the lives of so many people and almost every family has had a loved one affected by this terrible disease.

The money raised for the Terry Fox Foundation is used to fund medical research to fight the disease. The difference this has made for thousands of people is tremendous. The odds of beating many forms of cancer has increased significantly in the past 42 years (when Terry Fox began his Marathon of Hope) - in large part because of donation made by many Canadians.
