## Principal's Report:

- Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> is Principal's last day at Millgrove

- Kelly Rizzo from Balacalva (also now retired) will take over as another interim principal until December when we hope to have a permanent replacement

- Water Update: In April 2022, the chlorine contact tanks were changed. The water is tested 2x per day. Water samples are also sent monthly to an independent lab for testing. The flushing of taps occurs on Mondays.

- Lego Wall – still need trim around edges but it is being used. Have some Lego, but need more. Council members can bring in Lego from home first and then if more is still needed, we will put it out to general school population.

- Dinner and Skate – forms have gone home. Still organizing event.

**Mrs Bailey/Mrs Hayward – JK/SK** – Started Library visits. Literacy working on groups depending on levels. Student teacher from Brock starting in class.

**Mrs. DiToro/Mrs Coakwell – JK/SK** – Working on targeted literacy instruction. Learning how to dress for cold weather.

**Mrs. Frizell – Grade 1** – In math working on numeracy, patterning. In literacy working on phonics, and started in class reading groups and using the word wall. In social studies,

working on Relationships, Roles and Responsibilities.

**Mrs. May – Grade ½** - In Language working on making connections and PenPal letters. In math working on numeracy with coins and money. In social studies grade 1 working on local communities and grade 2 working on global communities.

**Mr. Kimmerly – Grade 2/3** – In math working on coding mazes and directions. In language working on Wild Eggs book study. In social studies working on people, environments and mapping. In art working on patterning.
