Book Swap:

1268 books donated

323 book taken from the swap, excluding what was taken at open house and kinder orientation

Made \$448 for the council

Options for the remaining books:

- 1. donate
- 2. Keep some for next year

Wendy will provide some boxes

Proposal to open to the public for the last hour of the event

Encourage kids to make bookmarks to sell at the event next year

Fundraising -

Pizza days - possibility of adding pepperoni

Lindsay will take on the spreadsheets if we move forward, still waiting for pricing from the pizza place

There will be extra waste with this option and additional waste

The group is in agreement to proceed with pepperoni

Looking at the possibility of opening up pizza orders in advance of the school year to begin pizza days earlier in the year

Sub/Pita days - questionnaire posted on facebook

We have sold 239 pitas and 384 subs

Subs make \$1.25 per sub and pitas make \$1 per pita

Option to do 1 month of sub and 1 month of pita, and alternate 1 month at a time

For June will do Monday for Plta, Wednesday for Sub and Friday for pizza

Lindsay will send a vote for smoothies via email

For September:

1. Halloween dance at the end of October, potential to bring prizes to amp up

Budget:

\$12,168 current balance + \$1000 pending from Cobbs fundraiser

Pending ~\$8100 to be spent on Carry over (\$2500), Grad (\$500), Agendas (\$100), Dinner & Skate reserve (\$1300), Pitas & Subs (\$887), Go for Green (\$500) and Pizza (\$1811) Leaving us with roughly \$5000 to spend

We need to be mindful that the council will be contributing to the cost of jungle sport an amount of \$5850 - \$5000 depending on cost to each student SPENDING:

Play day - materials (chalk, bubbles, etc.), freebies, possibility for council to put on a bbq. \$500 motion to spend by Lindsay and Donna Speaker - \$350 motion to spend by Chantel and Lindsay IPads - \$2500 motion to spend by Marissa and Kat Crawford lake trip - \$200 motion to spend Donna and Lindsay Jungle sport - \$1900 to be carried over for jungle sport
