## Principal's Report -

- EQAO from our Grade 3 students last year - amazing results!
- \#11 in HWDSB for math results. 20\%+ over the average across all subjects.
- Millgrove Results as follows: Reading - 79\% (province at 65\%, HWDSB at 62\%), Writing at 83\% (province at 59\%, HWDSB at 53\%), Mathematics at 88\% (province at 55\%, HWDSB at 42\%)
- Fire drills and lock down drills are now all complete. Won't be doing a bomb drill until Spring.
- Report cards will go home November $14^{\text {th }}$. Teacher interviews are back! They will be held Thursday November $16^{\text {th }}$ and Friday November $17^{\text {th }}$ (PA DAY)
