# **Budget Update**

- ★ Still have May & June M&M's to come, as well as June Subs & Booster Juice
- ★ Currently have \$9670 in the accounts
  - Less \$1500 Dinner & Skate carry forward
  - Less \$1000 Playground carry forward
  - Less \$4500 for the mural.
  - o Less \$500 Go 4 Green
  - Less approx \$200 for teacher spending
  - Less approx \$750 for Ice Cream truck for playday
  - Less approx \$100 for Agendas
  - Less approx \$50 for Yearbooks
- ★ Leaves about \$1000 left for spending (plus M&M's, Subs & BoosterJuice)
- ★ Things we still want to buy are a permanent outdoor classroom and fix outdoor kinder play area
- ★ Anything that costs over \$1K must be purchased by May 23
- ★ Heather said "TD Friends of the Environment" will help fund something like the outdoor learning classroom. Would need to apply for approval.

# **Fundraising**

- ★ Permission for the previously proposed Cider/Wine fundraiser was denied
- ★ The Book/Puzzle Swap raised \$136
  - Suggestion for future years is to call it something else other than a 'swap' since we still want people to come take books for a donation but they don't need to have anything to swap
