Protocols:

Our students are doing a fantastic job wearing their masks while inside the building and remembering to put their masks on when re entering the school after they have been outside for Phys. Ed and recess. Our teachers have been spending time on lessons regarding the importance of hand washing, social distancing, remaining in cohorts and wearing masks. These lessons will help keep us all safe.
