Daily Covid Screening

Mount Albion Families,

When we return to in-person classes, **all in-person students will need to complete the screener every morning** before coming to school. Students are only to come to school if they pass the screener.

AT SCHOOL -

STEP 1 – Complete the Screener at home **Screener**: <u>https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/</u>

STEP 2A – If your child passes the screener, please initial the yellow tracking calendar (paper copies were distributed in December, <u>Daily Covid Screening Log</u>) to indicate that your child has passed the screener and may come to school. Students will need to show this tracking calendar to their Period 1 teacher each morning. [As before, students who are able to independently read all the information and complete their own screening on the Ministry site (<u>https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/</u>), may do that independently and show their period 1 teacher the green "passed" screen.]

If your child needs a new copy of the yellow tracking calendar, on their first day back to inperson please indicate in their agenda that they passed the screener or email mountalbion@hwdsb.on.ca to confirm.

STEP 2B – If your child does <u>not</u> pass the screener, they are not to come to school. Please follow this flowchart if a child does not pass the screener: <u>COVID At Home Protocol-01-05-</u>2022. AT SCHOOL -

We will follow this flowchart if students develop symptoms: <u>COVID At School or Child Care</u> <u>Protocol-01-05-2022</u>

Additionally, students who become ill at school may be sent home with a voluntary PCR test. These tests can be taken at home and dropped off at a testing location. Instructions for these tests will be provided and completion is voluntary.
