

What is Parent (School) Council?

"The purpose of a school council is, through the active participation of parents, to improve student achievement and increase accountability of the education system to parents."

"Education is a partnership involving parents, students, teachers, principals, school boards, government, and the community."

How can I participate?

- If possible, join parent council as a member or executive and attend meetings that occur every 1-2 months
 - o Option for virtual call in
 - o **Childcare** is being looked into for 2024-25
 - Can also attend as observer/non-member
- If unable to join and/or attend meetings, still share your valuable ideas, feedback, advice with parent council executive or members
- Support fundraising opportunities
- Volunteer at events
- Respond to parent council requests for feedback, information, etc

Types of discussion topics at meetings:

- Advocating for return of award assemblies
- Safety and well-being of students and staff (e.g., deterrents for vandalism)
- Academic success of students (e.g., EQAO action plan)
- Fundraising ideas and planning
- Support for **nutrition** program
- Insight into what's happening at Mount Albion (e.g., extra curriculars, school trips, etc)
- Improving **communication** with parents
- Implementation of board policies & procedures
- In general, sharing a parent perspective on any discussion topic
