

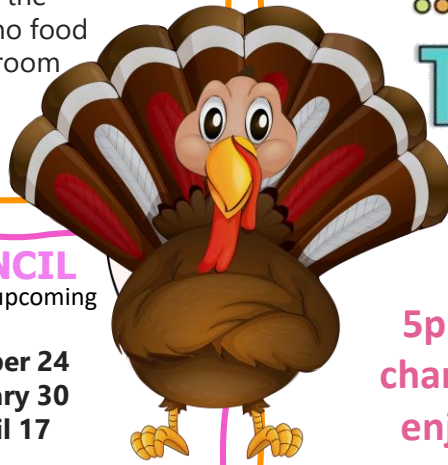

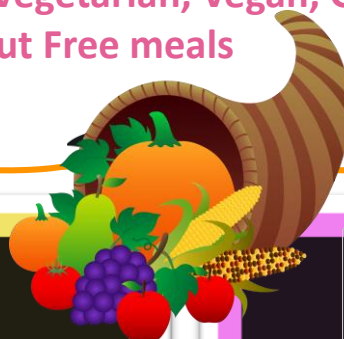


## Thursday October 10

### GRADE 8

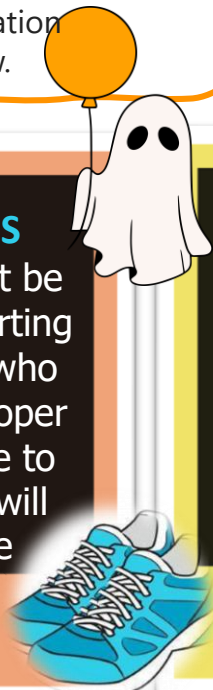
### SALFLEET NIGHT
