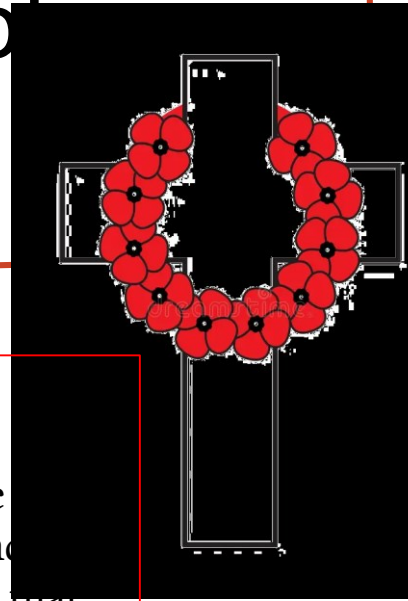

LOST & FOUND

At the end of every month we will be donating any unclaimed "lost & found" items to a local shelter. Please ensure that you label all clothing coming to school – so that we can bring lost items to their proper owners.



COLD WEATHER

All of the students should be wearing hats, gloves and even snow pants when the weather is cold and / or wet. An extra pair of socks and pants are sometimes handy to have at school when weather is damp or snowy.

We are requesting that the children wear their running shoes at school, not slippers. Sometimes floors may be wet and slippery causing safety issues. If we practice emergency evacuations, the students need to have proper footwear on. As well, labelling of clothing, boots and runners would eliminate confusion. There is a lost and found box at school that is overflowing with items that were lost and cannot be returned to the proper owner because they were not labelled. Remember to dress for the weather and label all clothing.

We watch the weather reports on our computers and use -15°C as our gauge when deciding if indoor recesses will occur. Hearing of school closures due to weather give us all reasons to plan ahead. Be sure to have alternate care arrangements for your children just in case. As we have sent out previous letters, pay close attention to all local television and radio stations for school closures.
