NO PETS ON THE PLAYGROUND

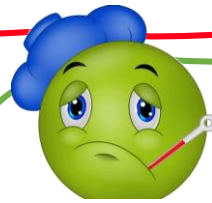
We know that pets are part of the family – but please leave them home when you come to pick up your kids. We cannot have dogs or other pets on the playground during drop off & pickup.
