### The 8 Awesome Topics For This Session Are:

COILED TURTLES From sleek sea turtles to sturdy, land-based tortoises, turtles come in many shapes and sizes, and can be found in many different habitats. We'll start by sculpting a coil to make the shell, and we'll add extra pieces and colors to make our own turtle sculptures.

DANCING JELLYFISH Jellyfish dance and drift through the water, and are found in every ocean on Earth! But what exactly are they? Let's dive in and learn about these mysterious creatures of the deep. We'll create colourful, mixed media hanging jellyfishes using a special ink diffusion technique.

**ELEPHANTS SILHOUETTES** Let's get inspired by elephants, the largest land mammals on Earth! We will learn techniques to paint a sunset background, and layer on dark silhouettes of elephants and trees.

LION SCULPTURES Lions are majestic animals, and fearsome predators. It's no wonder a group of them is called a "pride"! Let's learn how to create our own lion sculptures, and design savannah habitat dioramas for them to live in.

POLAR BEAR MODELS Polar bears are amazing animals that face many threats to their survival. Let's imagine what life is like for them in the Arctic. We'll sculpt our polar bears on an ice floe using clay. Then we'll mix paints and mixing mediums to create the effects of fur and ice

SLITHERING SNAKES Snakes are fascinating and often misunderstood reptiles. Their skin has a unique texture, and they come in a wide range of patterns and colors. Let's design our own three-dimensional, patterned snakes to take home.

SPECKLED FROGS Frogs come in many colors and patterns. Some are bold and some are camouflaged. Let's find out more about these amphibians, and use a special technique to paint speckled, watercolour frogs.

WATERCOLOUR SHARKS AND FISH The streamlined shapes of sharks and fishes are perfect for living in the water. We can use simple shapes to draw sharks and fishes in a coral reef. Then we will add watercolour paint to create a colourful scene under the sea.
