

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Mount Hope!

With a growing community, we look forward to welcoming our returning and new families. Please rely on our school website and the Parent Portal to access information and inform you of your child's school teacher for the 2022-23 school year.

Class placement is a collaborative team process that our educators invest in to create the most optimal classroom dynamic for our students. Thank you for respecting their professionalism to ensure your child will learn in the most optimal environment based on their learning skills and achievement. A considerable amount of time and thought goes into placement decisions. Please note, changes to class placements are not being considered at this time. Our dedicated and caring staff will work with you to support students in transitioning to their new classrooms. If you have any specific concerns about your child, please reach out to your child's teacher.

The first day of school is Tuesday, September 6th. On Tuesday, students in Grades 1-8, will meet their teachers at the back of the school on the black top. Students will look for a sign with their teacher's name on it. This is where they will connect with classmates and will find their teacher. At 9:15am, teachers will bring students into their perspective classrooms for the start of the day. Staff will be on the school yard to supervise and assist students 15 minutes before and after school each day.

For the safety of students, only school busses & staff vehicles will enter school grounds and our parking lot. Parents driving students from Grades 1-4 will continue to drop off & pick up students in Longview court where they will be supervised upon entry & dismissal. Parents driving students from Grades 5-8 will continue to drop off & pick up students on Marion Rd.

If you require any assistance, please look for a staff member in an orange vest who will be happy to help.

On Tuesday, September 6, 2022 all kindergarten children new to kindergarten and/or the school will have the opportunity for a short visit with a caregiver in order to ensure that they feel comfortable and supported as they transition to school. On Wednesday, September 7, 2022 all Kindergarten students begin full day attendance and will meet their educators in the fenced Kindergarten area in front of the school.

If your child is taking the bus this year, they will be met by staff upon arrival and supported by staff at the end of the day until buses arrive. It is very important that your child knows how they will be getting home at the end of each day. Please take some time to review this with your child. During start-up, bus transportation may experience some delays; your cooperation and
