Every school in Ontario is required to have a School Council to work collaboratively with the Principal to improve student achievement and to enhance accountability of the school with parents. School Councils meet in person at the school to discuss school-wide interests and to make recommendations to the Principal. School Councils must hold annual elections to identify voting members and various positions such as School Council Chair. Elected members vote on School Council matters and represent the group's ideas and advisory suggestions for the Principal. Please note that you do not have to be an elected member of School Council to attend meetings. All meetings are open to all parents/guardians who wish to attend. To declare your interest to become an elected member on School Council, please complete the nomination form shared via email. You may also nominate another parent/guardian of a student at our school to become an elected School Council Member. All nomination forms must be submitted by Friday, September 29, 2023 at 4 pm.

Please note that you must attend the meeting on Tuesday, October 3, 2023, in order to be elected to Council. Our first meeting of this school year will be held Tuesday October 3, 2021, at 6:00 pm in our school library. The nomination form will be shared via email to all Mount Hope families. Please consider joining us on School Council as an elected or general member, having parent voice on council contributes to the success of our school.

School Council involvement is a great way to support your child's education and we look forward to working together.
