Principals Message

Drop off & Pick Up

Milk Program

Our milk program is off to a strong start this year! Having said that, we wanted to make parents aware that because we operate off a ticket program, it is sometimes hard to predict how much milk will be required in a given week which sometimes results in a shortage of either chocolate or white milk. The shortage is usually on a Wednesday as our deliveries come Thursdays, so please keep this in mind when packing your child's lunch on a Wednesday. We do our best to predict demand and apologize for any shortages that may occur. Please be assured that if for some reason your child does not get milk on a particular day the milk tickets are returned to them to use at a different time.

Winter Weather

Yes, sadly, the warm weather is about to leave us and the colder weather is just around the corner. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing for outdoor recess (i.e. boots, hats, mitts, warm coat). If you need any assistance with these items, please contact the office. Please send along a pair of running shoes that can be kept at school as boots or just socks in school are not permitted. Students will be going outside up to -15 degrees so please make sure that they are prepared for the outdoors.
