

A course created for the 11 - 14 year old age group designed to teach babysitting, leadership and first aid skills in a fun and informative way.

Students will learn how to care for infants, toddlers and older children, questions to ask parents, how to apply basic first aid and how to respond to various emergencies.

Students will complete activities, participate in role-playing and practice hands-on skills to build their confidence caring for others. Students will receive a copy of the "What Every Babysitting Should Know" handbook and upon successful completion, a St. John Ambulance Babysitter's attendance certificate. Compact babysitting first aid kits are available for purchase at the time of registration for \$15 + tax.



Students learn how to identify an emergency and who to contact, personal safety, the importance of routines and healthy eating.

Students will complete activities, participate in role-playing and practice hands-on skills to build their confidence for staying home alone.

Students will receive a copy of the "Home Alone Program" reference guide and upon successful completion, a Home Alone attendance certificate.

This class is designed for 10 & 11 year olds whose parents feel they are mature enough to be left alone for short periods of time.
