
Radiation therapists use high-energy radiation to stop cancer cells from growing and dividing in cancer patients.






The radiation therapist positions the patient in the radiation machine so that the equipment can deliver a dose of radiation to the tumour.

DO NOT count***

University Prerequisites

- Upgraded mark policy varies from school to school. Some take the highest mark, some take an average and some give a penalty. Check your program at each school
- Check the minimum average required for your program. Apply where you will meet the required average.

Application Process Ontario Universities

- Apply online once you have your PIN number January 15, 2020 deadline
- Recommend that you apply by Dec. 31
- Receive PIN code & instructions from Mrs. Harris in Student Services (Guidance)

Application Process

- \$150.00 for 3 choices—University/program choices check policy of each school about applying to more than one program
- Additional choices \$50.00 each
- Feb. 4, 2020: Recommended last date for you to submit all information to the OUAC to be considered for early admission. This information includes university and program changes and additional active choices.

Marks Submission

Sent electronically by the school
 February, April, July

 Check your account on line and report any errors to your counsellor as soon as you discover them.

Timelines - University

- Feb April early offers (conditional)
- May most offers (conditional)
- May 27 last day you can expect a response
- June 1 date that most Universities require a response from you for an offer of admission
- July—offers can be rescinded depending on final marks!
- July & August Further offers made depending on space availibility

Out of Province Universities

- Check each university website to apply
- Some can access marks through OUAC if not you must request transcripts that you will send
- U.S.A. universities require SAT or ACT scores
- PSAT practice for SAT
