SafeArrival

This is a message to let you know that HWDSB is adopting a new system that will make it easier for you to report and respond to a child's school absences.

Once it is deployed in spring 2019, SafeArrival will let you use a website, mobile app, or an interactive toll-free phone number to report an absence in advance.

An email address is required to log in to SafeArrival and to receive notifications.

Accurate family phone numbers and email addresses must be recorded in each student record for SafeArrival to be a success.
