6. Principal's Report

- Progress reports will be going home soon (Nov 2) not an actual report card.
- Will focus on specific criteria.
- Parents will know ahead of time if children are "progressing with difficulty." Parents do not need to panic, but are encouraged to have a conversation with their teacher. With time and supports in place, we hope for children to move to progressing well.
- Teachers have been asked to comment on all of the learning skills. Most students will not be at "excellent."
- Parent interviews will be the Thursday and Friday after progress reports are delivered.
- Middle school teachers will be in the gym so that parents can go between teachers of different subject areas.
- Transition after the shuffle has gone well. Classes are much smaller. All the grade fives are getting a music period every week. Taking down chairs and tables makes it possible to provide instrumental program for grade fives.

7. Treasurer's Report - Amy Townsend

Report is accurate within about \$200, due to the money from t-shirts from the open house.

Many open accounts have now been closed.

There is hope to make some changes to how the accounts are run in order to have more access to funds throughout the year.

Goal will be to not have expenses carried over from year to year.

Goal is within 30 days of an event or purchase that funds are paid for - goal is to get receipts more quickly.
