Forms, Forms, & More Forms

Please make sure that you have completed an attestation form for every one of your children and that you are screening your children every morning for COVID related symptoms. Please do not send your children to school if they are feeling unwell. This year all emergency forms will be completed on-line through the Parent Portal. We will have more information on how to access these forms in the upcoming week.

Hand Sanitizer:

Students may bring their own bottle of hand sanitizer to keep at their desk or in their backpack. The bottle must not be larger than 60 ml.

Mask Exemption:

If your child is unable to wear a mask due to medical reasons, please fill out the mask exemption form on-line and contact the school principal to discuss. Thank you.

Safe Arrival & Lates:

Please contact the school using our safe arrival program if your child will be absent from school. All students arriving after the bell will go directly to their classroom. Parents are not permitted to enter the school building. If your child is to be excused before the end of the school day, please call the office to report this. We are not using paper agendas this year so communication will have to be through the phone or email. **Being on-time and ready to learn is fundamental to student success.**

Due to COVID, all fundraising, pizza days, milk, and school store has been suspended until further notice.
