This June, we're holding a virtual art show and we want you to take part! Each week, we'll give you a theme/prompt and invite you to draw a picture based on it. Then, take a photo of your art and submit it to be displayed in our online art gallery (full submission guidelines and website url coming soon!)

FREE ART SUPPLY KITS (paper, pencils, eraser and a 24-pack of pencil crayons) are available now – email queenvictoria@hwdsb.on.ca with students' names and **MAILING ADDRESS** to have a kit sent to your home. Printables with each week's theme are pre-printed in the art kits, and are available digitally for teachers and families.

The weekly themes for **DRAW TOGETHER** are:

- **Week 1 (May 31st to June 4th): The View Out My Window**
What do you see out your window at home? Or...use your imagination to show us what you **WISH** you saw instead?
Deadline to submit artwork for **Week One: Friday, June 4th**
- **Week 2 (June 7th to 11th): QV Staff Superheroes**
Invent A Superhero based on a QV staff member. What are their superpowers, and what tools do they use?
Deadline to submit artwork for **Week Two: Friday, June 11th**
- **Week 3 (June 14th to June 18th): QV in The Future**
What will QV look like in 2050, or 2121? How do you imagine our school in the future?
Deadline to submit artwork for **Week Three: Friday, June 18th**

Students' Artwork will be displayed in an online gallery, organized in three sections:

- **Primary (JK – Grade 3);**
- **Junior (Grades 4, 5 and 6);**
- **Intermediate (Grades 7 and 8)**

For privacy reasons, the students' names will **NOT** be displayed online with their artwork, but the gallery will be public, so we can share with family and friends.
