### Student council rep - Minah

Day Care (email sent to Jenn B form Julie Kott – Umbrella Supervisor who was off that day):

- Openings for preschoolers? = we currently are full for our preschool group, with 16
  preschoolers each day, with a large wait list in the event families withdraw
- 2. PA Day spots available? = we currently are full for the upcoming PA Day, running at a group of 13 children, which are all Ray Lewis families. For the June PA Days, current registration shows us as full for 2 groups of children, with a small wait list = for March Break we are also full, running with 2 groups of children (28 total)
- 3. Before/After school care? = we are currently full for our kinder group and have approximately 6 spaces for our SA groups
- 4. Any concerns? = no concerns at this time, but please let everyone know how much we appreciate you and the school educators' support of the program. Staff have been welcoming and supportive and we truly appreciate being able to work alongside your team, who truly care about the children at Ray Lewis that we all service.

## Upcoming PA Day – Friday March 4th

#### Public Health Measures & Covid Protocols:

Here is a summary of the measures here at Ray Lewis:

- Daily Screening Students need to complete and bring verification log signed to school each day.
- Masks Students and staff need to wear a mask (unless they have an exemption) when inside the building and when physical distancing cannot be maintained (2 metres).
- When at school, students learn and remain in their cohort/class for the instructional day. At nutrition breaks, students have designated cohort zones areas to move and play in.

- Staff and students are asked to physically distance (2metres) themselves as best as they can when interacting in classrooms, hallways. When it is not possible, masks and shields should be worn.
- Each classroom is provisioned with hand sanitizer. Students are asked to sanitize their hands when entering their learning spaces.
- Essential Workers and Third-Party Providers in the School (must sign in and provide prof of full vaccination)

• Continuity of Learning for Students who are ill and cannot attend. Teachers post to Hub and Teams.

• Self-Reported Positive Cases of Covid are posted on School Website

Staff and student safety measures are posted on school website and are sent home via School Messenger (email) as they change. They continue to be practiced and reinforced on a daily basis in school as we continue to follow best practices at Ray Lewis to keep everyone safe.
