<u>Health and Safety during Heat Events</u>: A heat event occurs when the forecast calls for one or more days with a 40 or higher humidex reading. The City of Hamilton Public Health Department monitors weather forecasts closely and notifies the media and community partners of a heat event. Once HWDSB has been notified of a heat event, information will be posted on our website and the following precautionary steps will be taken for students: Limit physical outdoor activities, ensure access to water, close drapes and blinds, and monitor students for symptoms of heat stress. Please try to send your child to school with a refillable water bottle during the month of June.

<u>Grade 8 Commencement:</u> Our Grade 8 students will be celebrating the end of their elementary journey on Tuesday June 21st at 6:00 p.m. The Commencement will take place in the school's gymnasium and will be followed by a reception in the library.
