REPORTING ABSENCES & EARLY DISMISSAL

Just like in-person learning, attendance is an important component to ensure the safety and well-being of our students. If you know that your child will be absent, please report the absence using the School Messenger system. This will avoid a system call out to you. If you know that your child will be dismissing early from virtual learning, kindly ensure that you advise your homeroom teacher. The safety of your child is our first priority.



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INSTRUCTIONAL TIME BETWEEN EDUCATORS AND STUDENTS

The Remote Kindergarten School day is organized by large and small group meetings throughout the day, led by educators.

It is important to maximize the instructional time between the teacher and students in order to support the creation of a positive classroom space. Using MS Teams tools like the Raise Hand and unmute buttons help students effectively communicate with each other and their educators. Students develop digital citizenship skills like turn taking and listening to the ideas and questions of others. With in-person learning, students have visual cues where they can see other students who have a question or are waiting to speak to the teacher. The visual cues give them comfort in knowing that their turn will come. In the virtual classroom, cues look different and require some specific skills and practice to make this happen. To support the growth of your child in the remote classroom, please consider the following:

- Ensure that your child can work in a quiet space with little background noise.
- Remind your child to use the participants button to see who else is waiting for the teacher before speaking.
- Encourage them to stay muted until called upon.
- If they are struggling to use an app or tool, encourage your child to ask the teacher to troubleshoot directly with them.

Just like in-person learning during the instructional day, communication must remain between the students and the educators. While there are no walls, the virtual classroom is reserved for the students and educators of that class. As the parent/guardian of a Kindergarten student, it is understandable that there are times when you need to communicate with your child's educators. We ask for your patience in waiting until the end of the meeting or alternatively, please email them directly.
