WEATHER

With the cooler (and often rapidly changing) winter weather, please make sure your child is dressed for the weather conditions. Our students are outside during entry time and 20 minutes during both outdoor breaks. Sometimes students will also be outside for short periods of time during Daily Physical Activity time. Students will stay inside if there is a cold weather alert (colder than -15 degrees Celsius before wind chill) or -20 degrees Celsius or below with the wind chill).

PARKING

If you driving your child to school, please park in the school parking lot as it is a safe walking route to the school playground. To help keep everyone safe, please obey all parking and stopping regulations as signed. To limit traffic at the school area, the school encourages students who are assigned to a bus to ride the bus to and from school and students within walking distance to walk to and from school, weather permitting.
