#### School Messenger Safe Arrival Reporting Process

A reminder that all families should be signed up to report your children's absences through the School Messenger app or website. Please see the school or board website for more information on how to sign up.

#### VOLUNTEERS MUST HAVE POLICE CHECK: VULNERABLE SECTOR SCREENING

Part of the HWDSB Volunteer Policy is that any volunteers working with children must have obtained a Vulnerable Sector Screening Report. This is essentially a criminal record check and is put in place to protect our students. To obtain such a report an adult must pick up an application form from the Police Station or on-line and take it to the Hamilton Police Services Headquarters on King William Street in Hamilton. There is a cost and it is valid for 3 years with the HWDSB.

It could take up to 4 - 6 weeks for the report to be prepared. Once you have obtained the report, bring it to the school office for approval and to complete the Volunteer Forms. If you are thinking of volunteering, it is a good idea to get a Screening as soon as possible, so that you can take advantage of opportunities as they arise. You will not be permitted to attend school trips without a Police Check!

#### **BUS TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY**

Busing is only available to students who receive confirmation of transportation during the month of <u>August</u> each school year.

If your child does not meet criteria for transportation to RL Hyslop School, a Courtesy Transportation Application form can be submitted to the school Principal. As our school buses are reaching capacity, minimal, if any, Courtesy Transportation Applications will be approved.

Possible approval may **begin October 1st**, **2019**. An application form can be picked up at the office in September. Please complete the form and return it to the school office as soon as possible. **No courtesy riders will be allowed to ride the bus until October 1st and only once approval with written permission from the Principal is granted.** Courtesy transportation is not granted on a first-come, first-serve basis as many factors are taken into consideration.

#### WHAT DISTANCE DO I HAVE TO LIVE FROM MY DESIGNATED SCOOL TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSPORATION?

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board believes in providing the best possible learning environment for its students. This includes providing safe, secure and on time transportation to and from school for eligible students.

Students will be eligible for transportation services to their <u>in-catchment</u> school when the walking distance exceeds the following:

Elementary School Kindergarten Students: 1.0 km Grade 1 – 8 Students: 1.6 km



Secondary School Grade 9 – 12 Students: 3.2 km

Parents of a child within the designated walking requirements have the primary duty of care to ensure the safe arrival of their child to school.
