They go outside 1st, 1 or 2 at he Gaga ball pit, 1 or 2 on the playground, a couple referring a soccer game, if they see someone on the buddy bench alone, they could go over and chat with them, if someone gets hurt help them get to a teacher.

Grade 6,7&8s get a lot of opportunities we feel the Grade 5s are ready and looking for things to lead.

To start all Grade 5s are giving it a try after a couple of weeks students can decide if they want to continue.

GaGa Ball pit has been a huge hit! Students had to learn how to play during their gym and DPA classes before they can use at recess, a schedule has been made.
