#### Welcome Back Rosedale Families!

We are excited about welcoming back students to the 2020-21 school year. The pandemic has brought many changes to our school and its families, but I know that we can rise to the occasion if we work together.

Thank you for keeping up with the communications coming from HWDSB via the website and synervoice messaging, and for completing important forms and surveys as required through the Parent Portal.

We are taking many actions to prevent COVID-19 at our school. You will notice that safety is guiding our programming choices. Here are some of the important points to remember:

#### Attestation

**Before a student can enter a school**, we require that their family completes an attestation that they have read, understood, and will abide by expectations. Find this on the <u>Parent Portal</u>. (<u>Backup location</u> for forms and translations.)

## **Daily COVID-19 Screening**

HWDSB COVID-19 Student Screening Checklist is to be completed daily before arriving at school. The checklist is found on the Parent Portal as well as on the <u>HWDSB website</u>. **If you answered YES to any of the screening questions, or if you refuse to answer the questions, the student has failed the screening and must not attend school.** The family should contact Public Health (905) 974-9848 or their family doctor for testing. Please contact the school using <u>SafeArrival</u> to report the absence. If the student is tested for COVID-19, your school would appreciate knowing the outcome of that test.

# **Staggered start details**

As you know, we will be opening our school with a staggered start timeline. This means that not all students will begin on the same day. Please see the chart below and note into which group your child falls and reach out if you have more questions. Please note: Special Education students requiring a Transition meeting and JK students will be contacted with specific times for visiting the school. These are NOT full days, but introduction visits only.

# New routines and protocols

### **Water Bottles**

Drinking fountains in all schools will be bagged and not used. Please be sure to send your child with a labelled, reusable water bottle so they stay hydrated, in addition to their non-medical mask.

## **Visiting Schools**

This year, our school must significantly limit or even prohibit visitors to school, including parents, to support a safe and healthy learning environment. We ask families to call or email our school if they need to supply information or contact a staff member.

## **Junior Kindergarten Orientation**

Parents of Junior Kindergarten students will be contacted by their child's teacher and invited to a virtual orientation meeting via MS TEAMS on Thursday, September 17<sup>th</sup> or Friday, September 18<sup>th</sup>. You will also be invited to come in with your child for a short, touchless tour of the classroom and to meet your teacher and DECE.

## **Elementary reorganization**

Due to the number of students opting to start the year with online learning we have lost a Primary class and a Junior class from the organization that I announced to the community at the end of June. We were required to re-organize our school and the present organization is as follows:

Classroom teachers will be contacting parents to welcome students to their classrooms. Due to the nature of this school year, and the 3 re-entry points for students throughout the year, the above could change at any time. There will be NO movement of students into different classes.
