Minutes from previous meeting: 1st Phil, 2nd Emily.

Treasurers report: Popcorn fluctuating between \$150-200. Had to pay for popcorn + gift shop purchases. \$11,500 in account. Need to start spending \$!

Presidents report: Dan attended a meeting last night. Webinar discussing how to run a fundraiser, what funds can be used for, etc slide will be sent out to all. May 2-3 OFSA conference (Best Western in Brantford). We need to decide if we want to send anyone. Focus is on personal wellness. Encouraged to use funds to send any interested participants. Cost per individual is approx \$125 + includes lunch. Previous home and school president went last year. Said it was valuable. Will assess interest this year. We CAN earmark for funds next year. Need to commit to spending money on whatever is specified. You can and MUST carry over enough to start you off in the 2024/2025 school year.

Fundraising update: Dominos. Will know by next Monday how much was raised.

Bake sale: Within the school, or community bake sale? Lynsey: Committee event may open a wider net for fundraising. Movie night—talking to Rosedale Arena. Stay tuned! Dan: we don't need to have a vote on fundraiser (unless there are major concerns or opposition). Subcommittee can speak amongst themselves and initiate event. Jen: Could we run bake sale at the Easter Egg hunt with the Softball association?

Yoga or Pilates in the school yard. Charge \$10 (?) and give 1/2 to instructor and the other to the home and school. Is the field school board property? Do we need a permit to use the grass? Laura: I don't think so. It could be a pop-up. Gym would be a rental if after hours. Will engage an instructor and go from there. Sam N will follow up with Jo. Major spring fundraiser: Recommendations; big box of cards. Boxes are \$35 and contain 35 cards. H&S would earn \$11 per box sold. The risk is sometimes the sample boxes don't make it back. Looking into April to run this event. Emily: Do they want to send a sample box for everyone? We tell them how many, they send samples. Are we doing Wally Parr? No. Lots of negative feedback last year. If this group is interested Dan will look into it and see how a gift card only option. Concerns re big box cards funraiser: Costco is now selling for cheaper.
