School Programming Options

Welcome to the Library! (All grades, K-8)

During this visit, students will be introduced to the public library's programs, collections and resources in a fun and interactive way. Activities may include a storytime or scavenger hunt, and a tour of the local branch. These visits are tailored to the grade and learning objectives.

Summer Reading Club Promo! (All grades, K-8)

During this visit, students will be introduced to HPL's Summer Reading Club. This annual program runs July-August and encourages children and their families to read and engage with the library all summer long! Activities can include a storytime and/or interactive activity that fosters excitement for summer learning. **Available May 12**, **2025 to June 25**, **2025**.

Library Scientists (Grade 2)

In this interactive program, students will explore STEM concepts through hands-on activities with a literacy connection, including coding/robotic manipulatives (Ozobots, cublets, etc.) as well as exploring the library's makerspace (3D printer, sound studio, button maker, circuit, sewing machine, etc.) Activities may vary based on resource availability.
