

September 2025 Update

Welcome back new and returning Rosedale families. We hope your summer was filled with sunshine, laughter, love and joy. We look forward to seeing you again.

September class placements: Are available in the Parent Portal the week before school begins (August 25th). Families may also call the school during the week of August 25 for this information, however we encourage you to check the parent portal before calling. In addition, each September, enrollment is revisited by HWDSB, and there is always the potential for **school reorganization**. This typically occurs by Thanksgiving. Please note that as a result of reorganization, **classes may change**. If your child's placement changes this fall, you will be notified via letter.

Bussing – Hamilton-Wentworth Student Transportation Services (HWSTS) will be contacting all eligible families with transportation information by the end of August. If you have yet to hear from transportation regarding your child's bus stop location and pick up/drop off time please call 905 523 2318. School Entry and Exit Routines - Our yard is supervised beginning at 8:05 am each morning. Please arrive no earlier than 8:05 am. Our warning bell rings at 8:18 am each day. At this time students are asked to independently join their classroom line and prepare for 8:20 am entry. It is important that all students enter the school on time with their classmates. Please ensure your child is ready and on time each day.

Morning announcements provide valuable information to students about daily school events and opportunities, and are important for everyone to hear. Once announcements begin, our front doors are locked, and students will need to wait outside until announcements are over. At this time students will be checked in and marked as late.

Our end of day warning bell sounds at 2:38 pm daily with students being dismissed at 2:40 pm. Please promptly pick up your child at the gate as they are released from their supervising teacher. Please remain behind the gates until students are released at 2:40 pm.

Kindergarten Students – Kindergarten staff will inform families about entry and exit procedures each day from our Kindergarten learning area.

Parents and Guardians – For the safety of everyone, we ask that you remain behind the gates and not on the playground area before the am and pm bell time each day. Please allow your child to enter the gates independently. There are a number of supervising staff onsite wearing orange vests who are there

to support all students. Our Kindergarten staff will support their former SK students to their Grade 1 line on the first day of school.

Canine Friends – Dogs are not permitted on school grounds between the hours of 8:05 am and 2:55 pm daily for safety reasons.

Codes of Conduct

Policy/Program Memorandum 128 took effect on September 1, 2024 in all schools in Ontario. This will help to further enforce a positive school climate that supports the achievement and well-being of all HWDSB students and respects all human rights.

Early end of day pick up – If you are planning to pick up your child early from school, please message your child's teacher. **We ask that you pick up your child by 2:15 pm**. End of day is a very busy time in schools as students are transitioning. As well, early pick up is often disruptive for everyone in the classroom as teachers are reviewing the day, writing in the agenda, and preparing students for the next day of learning. We thank you for supporting our end of day routines to ensure smooth communication and transitions for everyone.

Student information – Please ensure that our office is notified of changes in address, contact information, emergency contact information and medical information/updates. This information supports the office in the event that we need to contact you about your child during the school day.

Medical Plans of Care & student oral medications – In June, students with medical plans of care were sent home renewal forms for September 2025 start up. Please send completed/updated forms back to school with your child as soon as possible.

Healthy Lunches and Snacks – Please ensure your child's lunch offers items that nourish the mind and body. Too many packaged and processed foods do not offer the nutrition growing minds and bodies require. We encourage fresh fruits and vegetables, whole grains, and water to drink. Please be reminded that Rosedale and all HWDSB buildings are nut safe environments. Products such as nut butters, Nutella, and chocolates with peanuts/nuts are just a few items that present fatal health hazards for some of our students.

Birthday Celebrations – We appreciate your desire to celebrate your child's special day with classmates in celebration of their birthday. Due to food allergens, medical diagnoses, and cultural beliefs/ preferences, food items such as cakes, cupcakes, cookies, ice cream, popsicles, candies, and other confections will not be permitted for distribution to classmates. Please speak to your child's teacher about alternatives to food items such as classroom craft materials, books, games, learning supplies and other specific needs of the classroom in honour of your child's special day.

Pizza, Snack Program, and Special Lunch days – Information will be shared in the very near future regarding these school-based initiatives.
