## **Meeting Summary**

1. Welcome – By Mr. Gris including the Land Acknowledgement.

- 2. Student Report Finley Holt and Sophia Manzine
  - "Beach Day" Spirit Day Friday May 28, 2021.
  - Thank you from the students for the opportunity to purchase grad-wear and yearbooks that
    were made available to the grade 6 class. The students find the grad-wear cozy and
    comfortable and are also appreciative of the time and effort that was given to the creation
    of the yearbook.
  - Students are keeping in touch with each other through virtual forms of communication during the current lockdown.
- 3. *Teacher Report* Ms. Fawcett/Ms. Bennett
  - Virtual Talent Show for Grades 1-6 Video auditions will be held in the coming weeks and the final production piece will be posted the last week of school.
  - Grade 6 celebration will likely be another virtual ceremony which will be similar to the 2019/2020 year.
  - Scientists in Schools Opportunity to have two classes attend a virtual program that will be attended by the Grades 5 and 6 students. Materials will be included in the cost and will be provided in advance of the virtual visit.
- 4. Principal's Report
  - Student Census

  - Facilities Update:
    - Mr. Labelle has delivered the blackboard for the outdoor classroom to be installed outside when students return. Total cost was approximately \$400 from the

- principal's fund for the material. Next year the students will decorate the back of the blackboard to deter graffiti.
- Stumps have been donated to the children's playground and will be installed by the blackboard installations.
- Remote Learning
  - Parent portal is now open to select if students want to select in-person or remote learning in 2021/2022 school year. Preference needs to be completed by June 1<sup>st</sup>; otherwise in-class learning would be assumed.
- Learn.Disrupt.Rebuild
  - Materials are now available to parents in addition to teachers for Modules 1 and 2
    to reinforce the learning that is completed with the teachers. Module 3 is currently
    being taught in the classrooms. Module 4 will be introduced in September.

  - \$1,500 per engagement

  - Addresses unconscious bias
