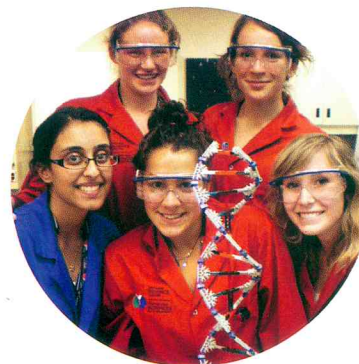

Imagine taking classes at the Ontario Science Centre! The Ontario Science Centre Science School offers students a chance to earn their Grade 12 science and math credits and prepare for university in a unique setting. Though you need to be academically strong, you don't need to have the very highest grades to attend this program. You do, however, need a love of science, a desire to learn, and a real interest in interacting with people.

Try Something New

Classes are enriched by field trips, guest speakers, and extracurricular activities. Experienced, enthusiastic, and imaginative teachers help you to acquire a solid academic background within the environment of a world-class science centre.

Innovate, Create, Communicate

With a strong emphasis on science engagement and communication, you'll gain experience through practicum hours spent participating in activities with visitors and the local community. You can use your practicum hours toward the 40 Community Service Hours required by the Ministry of Education.

How to Apply

Selection is based on your written application, academic record, and recommendations from two teachers, one of whom must be a science or mathematics teacher. The final selection may include an interview process. Up to 30 students are selected from across Ontario for each semester.

COURSES

Students choose three of the following:

Biology SBI4U

Chemistry SCH4U

Physics SPH4U

**Advanced Functions MHF4U
(First Semester ONLY)**

**Calculus and Vectors MCV4U
(Second Semester ONLY)**

Students cannot register for courses for which they have previously earned a credit.

NO FEES

No tuition fees are required. The program is offered through the Toronto District School Board and Toronto Catholic District School Board. Students will be registered with one of these two school boards while attending the Science School.

HOUSING

Students are responsible for arranging their own accommodation. A list of individuals who have contacted the Science School with accommodations for rent will be shared with students once they have been selected for the program. Please note that the Science School does not screen these accommodations or the people offering them.
