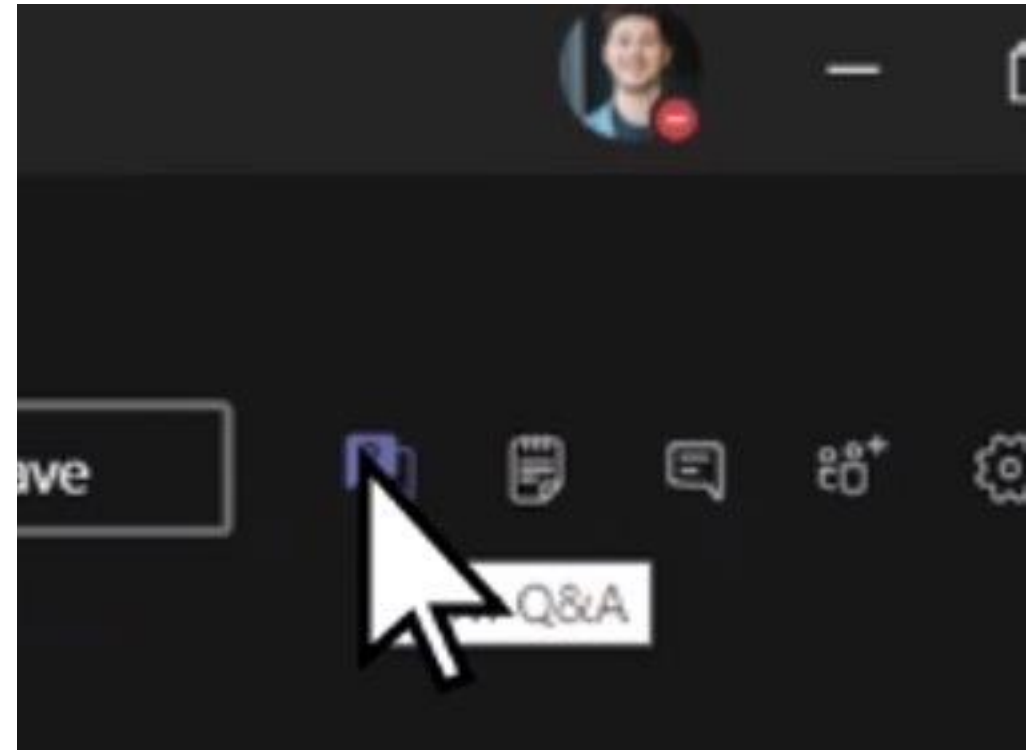

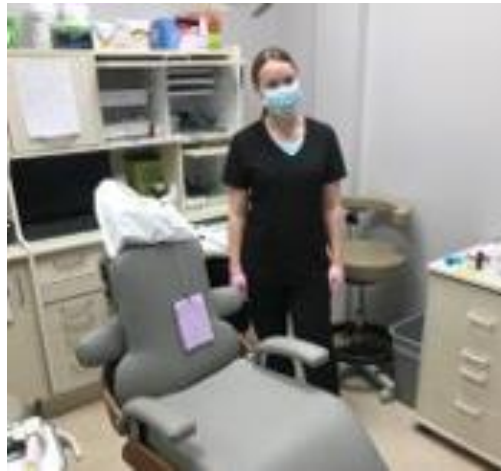
Coop allows you to earn secondary school credits while completing a work placement.
