

When done...

- REVIEW your choices and make sure there are no red icons beside your courses. If so, then contact your Guidance Counsellor
- NOTE: if you selected a course with an "eL" at the end of it, it is an eLearning course that will be taught through the HUB asynchronously (not live)
- Once you click SUBMIT, your courses will be <u>locked</u> and no longer accessible (contact your Guidance Counsellor for assistance)
- There are scheduled times to make CHANGES to your selections; there are no guarantees to get the course you want to change to, therefore, choose well the first time.
- Your <u>parent/guardian</u> will need to go into Parent Portal to APPROVE/VERIFY your choices....stay tuned for more information on when
- Should a class be CANCELLED, you will be notified by your Guidance Counsellor via email




AUGUST 2023 ORIENTATION
