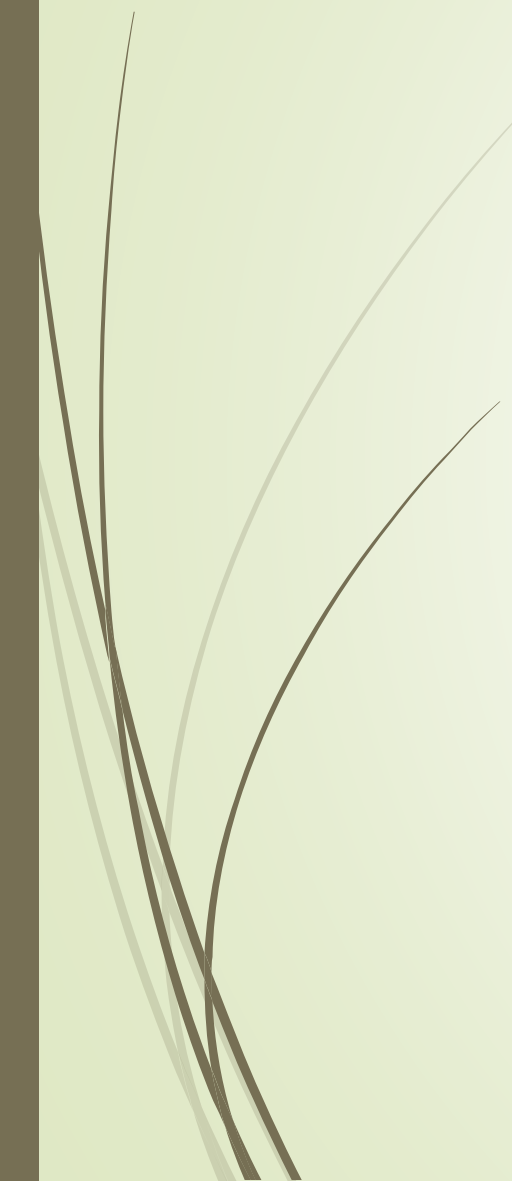

# When done...

- ▶ REVIEW your choices and make sure there are no red icons beside your courses. If so, then contact your Guidance Counsellor
- ▶ NOTE: if you selected a course with an "eL" at the end of it, it is an eLearning course that will be taught through the HUB asynchronously (not live)
- ▶ Once you click SUBMIT, your courses will be **locked** and no longer accessible (contact your Guidance Counsellor for assistance)
- ▶ There are scheduled times to make CHANGES to your selections; there are no guarantees to get the course you want to change to, therefore, choose well the first time.
- ▶ Your **parent/guardian** will need to go into Parent Portal to APPROVE/VERIFY your choices....stay tuned for more information on when

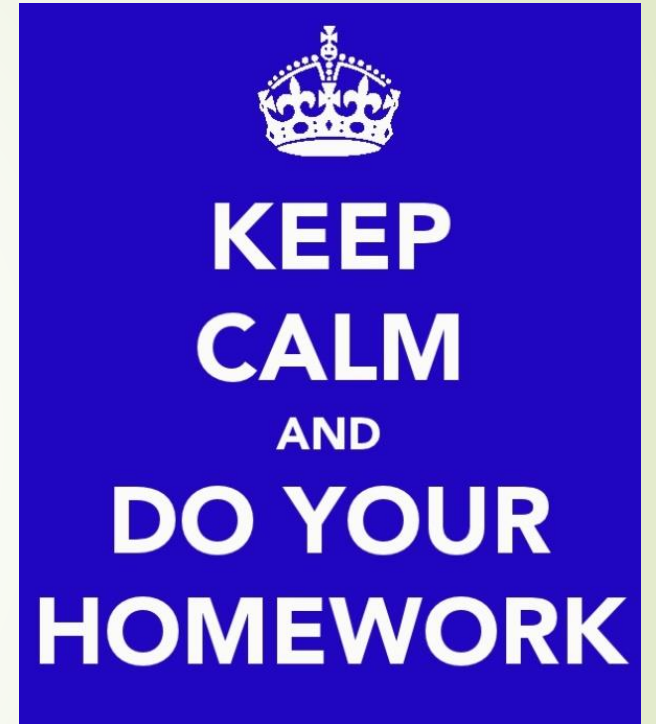
**We will be having an Orientation Session at the end of August to welcome you to Saltfleet.**
