Basic Requirements

Community Service Hours

- You must complete at least 40 hours of Volunteer Community Service in order to graduate

* PAID Positions

Community Service Hours

- Students aged 14 and older can count UP TO A
 MAXIMUM OF 10 HOURS from PAID
 <u>EMPLOYMENT</u> towards their earned hours <u>AT THE</u>
 DISCRETION OF THE PRINCIPAL!
- Students counting paid employment towards their graduation requirement will be required to complete their Record of Hours form and reflection questions, indicating hour their work contributed to the service of others
- Students not graduating this school year are required to complete 40-hours before April 1st of their graduating year

- When using paid employment for volunteer hours, you MUST e-mail your guidance counsellor with the following:
 - 1) Community Involvement Hours Record Form
 - 2) Your answers to the following reflection questions:
 - What as the activity and what were your duties (2-3 sentences)?
 - How was your involvement valuable to others (2-3 sentences)?

Additional Information

Community Service Hours

- You must ensure that the activity you are participating in meets the requirements of Community Involvement as outlined on the HWDSB website:
 - https://www.hwdsb.on.ca/wpcontent/uploads/2012/08/Community-Service-Facts.pdf
- Return your form as you complete your hours to keep your record up to date - you can also attach signed letters verifying the completion of your activity

- You can begin accruing your volunteer hours as of July 1st after you finish Grade 8
- You are encouraged to complete a minimum of 10 hours each academic year to ensure you are on track for graduation!

ReStore Volunteer


- The Habitat Hamilton ReStore (located on Nash Road) is in need of volunteers to help with customer service
